
GLIMPSATONE An Installation by Martin Johnson

Johnson's installation of found objects and found phrases reincarnates our discarded merchandise and idioms, inventing alliances of the fragments that would not have been formalized in their past lives. The process is a clue to the content of Johnson's work - we were what we have given up, we will be what we create from it.

Or, as Martin Johnson has written: "Quest in to of or as if it is for. (For) life, like art itself, begins and ends in mystery."

Johnson's work is riddled with it.
