The words and phrases, for example, "Home Working Out," "Show Doweffec Lic," and "Rereflectiflecti," frequently combine extraneous alphabetical lettering and versatile letter spacing, combined with traditional word construction. The canvases each contain individuated subject matter, providing

an accumulated quantity of visual information which can be emotionally cross-referenced as one's eyes move around the canvases as if the paintings were one large work, framed at all of

the different edges.
